"AN ACT CREATING A TASK FORCE TO IMPROVE THE WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT SYSTEM IN THE STATE OF CONNECTICUT."

1 Strike subdivision (6) of subsection (a) of section 4 in its entirety and
2 substitute the following in lieu thereof:

3 "(6) "Participating agency" means the Connecticut State Colleges
4 and Universities, Department of Education, Labor Department, The
5 Office of Early Childhood, The University of Connecticut or any entity
6 that has executed a memorandum of agreement for participation in the
7 CP20 WIN and has been approved for participation by all other
8 participating agencies."

9 Strike subsection (c) of section 4 in its entirety and substitute the

10 following in lieu thereof:

11 "(c) The CP20 WIN shall be governed by an executive board that
12 shall provide oversight of such network. Said executive board shall
13 consist of the following members: The Labor Commissioner, or said
14 commissioner's designee, the Commissioner of Education, or said
15 commissioner's designee, the Commissioner of Early Childhood, or
16 said commissioner's designee, the president of the Connecticut State
17 Colleges and Universities, or the president's designee, the president of
18 The University of Connecticut, or the president's designee and the
19 secretary of the Office of Policy and Management, or the secretary's
20 designee. The duties of the executive board shall be to:

21 (1) Advance a vision for the CP20 WIN including a prioritized
22 research agenda with support from the Planning Commission for
23 Higher Education.

24 (2) Convene as needed to respond to issues from the data governing
25 board.

26 (3) Identify and work to secure resources necessary to sustain CP20
27 WIN funding.

28 (4) Support system implementation, maintenance and improvement
29 by advocating for the CP20 WIN in regard to policy, legislation and
30 resources.

31 (5) Advocate and support the state's vision for the CP20 WIN.

32 (6) Have overall fiscal and policy responsibility for the CP20 WIN.

33 (7) Ensure that, in any circumstances in which public funds or
34 resources are to be jointly utilized with those from private entities,
35 such arrangements are governed by appropriate agreements approved
36 by the Attorney General.

37 (8) Establish a data governing board to establish and enforce
38 policies related to cross-agency data management, including, but not

39 limited to, data confidentiality and security in alignment with the
40 vision for CP20 WIN and any applicable law. In establishing such
41 policies, the data governing board shall consult with the Office of
42 Policy and Management, in accordance with the provisions of section
43 4-67n of the general statutes and other applicable statutes and
44 policies."
