Explanation

The bill, which makes clarifications regarding when facility fees may be charged and creates certain signage requirements for a freestanding, hospital-based emergency department, results in no fiscal impact to the state or municipalities. None of the clarifications and requirements applies to the University of Connecticut Health Center's practices or facilities, and no impact is anticipated to state or municipal health plans.

House "A" strikes the underlying bill, which had no fiscal impact, and replaces it with the impact described above.
