OMBUDSMAN WITH THE OLDER AMERICANS ACT.

Explanation

The bill, which brings Connecticut's Long-Term Care Ombudsman program¹ into conformance with federal regulations and requirements of the Administration for Community Living under the Older Americans Act (OAA)², has no fiscal impact as the program has the expertise to fulfill the federal requirements.
