

To whom it may concern:

I'm a constituent of Toni Boucher and Gail Lavielle in Wilton. As a craft beer enthusiast I have been thrilled to see the opening of new breweries close to my home including Nod Hill Brewery and Redding Brewing Company.

I wanted to write to express my support of H.B. 5036 which aims to create a better economic environment for micro breweries such as these. I frequently visit other craft breweries such as Tree House Brewing Company in Massachusetts where I can buy several cases of beer at a time, which I will usually resell to friends and family in the area. Higher limits on can and growler sales have allowed breweries in neighboring states to benefit from growth and revenues that would not be possible with the current laws in Connecticut, which prevent breweries from selling a full case of 24x16oz cans as this is over the 9L limit. I believe adding a line item to this bill that increases this limit to allow sale of several cases at a time would be a boon to our burgeoning craft brewing industry.
