SB 221 **“An Act Increasing The Fine For Failing To Move Over For An Emergency Vehicle And Injuring The Operator Of The Emergency Vehicle”**

HB 5220 **“An Act Authorizing Third-Party Fingerprinting Services”**

HB 5229 **“An Act Concerning Reimbursement For The Purchase Of Dashboard Cameras With A Remote Recorder And Digital Data Storage Devices Or Services”**

HB 5223 **“An Act Concerning Pursuits by Police Officers”**

CCM supports SB 221 as a mechanism to enforce a law that keeps our public safety officials safe when conducting work along the side of the road.

CCM supports 5220 as an effort to assist local police departments reduce administrative cost and time.

CCM supports 5229 to assist certain municipalities the ability to acquire dashboard cameras and data storage equipment.
