AN ACT REIMBURSING CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES FOR THE LOSS OF MOTOR VEHICLE TAX REVENUE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the sum of ten million dollars be appropriated to the Office of
- 2 Policy and Management, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year
- 3 ending June 30, 2019, to reimburse the municipalities of Torrington,
- 4 Hamden and Bridgeport for motor vehicle tax revenue shortfalls
- 5 occurring because said towns conducted property tax revaluations
- 6 after 2015.

Statement of Purpose:

To reimburse three municipalities that conducted revaluations after 2015 for lost motor vehicle tax revenue.
