AN ACT CONCERNING A QUARTERLY FEE PAYMENT BY CERTAIN EMPLOYERS AND FRANCHISORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require employers with
- 2 over five hundred employees in the state and franchisors that,
- 3 combined with their franchisees, employ at least five hundred
- 4 employees in the state, pay a quarterly fee to the Labor Commissioner
- 5 based in part on the number of hours worked by employees who were
- 6 paid on average less than fifteen dollars per hour during the quarter.

Statement of Purpose:

To require certain employers and franchisors to pay a quarterly fee based in part on the number of hours worked by employees who were paid on average less than fifteen dollars per hour during the quarter.
