**AN ACT CONCERNING NOTIFICATION BY CONTRACTORS TO
BOARDS OF EDUCATION REGARDING INCIDENTS OF ARREST OF
EMPLOYEES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2018*) Any contractor who (1)
2 contracts with a local or regional board of education, and (2) receives
3 information that an employee of such contractor, who is in a position
4 involving direct contact with a student in a school under such board's
5 jurisdiction, has been arrested, such contractor shall, not later than
6 twenty-four hours after receipt of such information, notify the board of
7 such employee's arrest. Such notification shall be in writing and
8 include the identity of such employee, and, if known by the contractor,
9 the offense or offenses for which such employee was arrested and a
10 brief description of the incident or incidents leading to the arrest.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
sections:
