AN ACT CONCERNING THE COLLECTION AND USAGE OF HEALTH CARE DATA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) The Office of Health
2 Strategy shall develop, within available appropriations, an annual
3 inventory of health care data collected by the office and the usage of
4 such data by the office.

5 (b) On or before January 1, 2019, and annually thereafter, the office
6 shall report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the
7 general statutes, to the joint standing committee of the General
8 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to public health
9 regarding the inventory developed pursuant to subsection (a) of this
10 section, its analysis of such inventory and any recommended
11 legislation in consideration thereof.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	<i>from passage</i>	New section
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Statement of Purpose:

To require the Office of Health Strategy to inventory the health care data collected by said office and its usage of such data.
