***AN ACT CONCERNING A NONEXPIRING AMMUNITION PERMIT.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 29-38o of the general statutes is repealed and the  
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2018*):

3 (a) The fee for each ammunition certificate originally issued under  
4 the provisions of this section shall be (1) thirty-five dollars in the case  
5 of a five-year certificate and for each renewal thereof thirty-five  
6 dollars, [which fees] or (2) one hundred dollars in the case of a  
7 nonexpiring permit. Any such fee shall be paid to the Commissioner of  
8 Emergency Services and Public Protection and shall be in addition to  
9 the fee paid pursuant to subsection (b) of section 29-17a for conducting  
10 the national criminal history records check. Upon deposit of such fees  
11 in the General Fund, the fees shall be credited to the appropriation to  
12 the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection to a  
13 separate nonlapsing account for the purposes of the issuance of  
14 ammunition certificates under section 29-38n.

15 (b) [An] (1) A five-year ammunition certificate originally issued

16 under the provisions of section 29-38n shall expire five years after the  
17 date it becomes effective and each renewal thereof shall expire five  
18 years after the expiration date of the certificate being renewed.

19 [(c)] (2) The renewal fee shall apply for each renewal of a five-year  
20 ammunition certificate that is requested not earlier than thirty-one  
21 days before, and not later than thirty-one days after, the expiration  
22 date of the certificate being renewed.

23 (3) A nonexpiring ammunition certificate shall not be subject to an  
24 expiration date, but shall be subject to the same provisions concerning  
25 revocation as those which apply to a five-year ammunition certificate  
26 pursuant to section 29-38p.

27 [(d)] (c) No fee or portion thereof paid under the provisions of this  
28 section for issuance or renewal of an ammunition certificate shall be  
29 refundable except if the certificate for which the fee or portion thereof  
30 was paid was not issued or renewed.

31 [(e)] (d) An ammunition certificate issued pursuant to section 29-38n  
32 shall be valid for a period of ninety days from the expiration date,  
33 except this provision shall not apply to any certificate which has been  
34 revoked or for which revocation is pending, pursuant to section 29-  
35 38p.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
