## Substitute Bill No. 5563



## AN ACT CONCERNING ROBO CALLS AND SPOOFING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- Section 1. Section 16-256e of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2018*):
- 3 (a) No person may use any device which transmits an unsolicited
- 4 recorded telephone message for any commercial, business or
- 5 advertising purpose to any telephone customer in the state and which
- 6 continues the call and message after the customer hangs up the
- 7 receiver. Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be
- 8 fined not more than one thousand dollars.
- 9 (b) Any person who violates the provisions of subsection (a) of this
- 10 section while intentionally using a blocking device or service to
- 11 <u>circumvent a telephone customer's use of a caller identification service</u>
- or device shall be guilty of a class A misdemeanor.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

## Statement of Legislative Commissioners:

In Section 1(b), "consumer's" was changed to "telephone customer's" for consistency with Subsection (a).
