AN ACT CONCERNING INDOOR TANNING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 19a-232 of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
3 *October 1, 2018*):

4 (b) An operator shall not allow any person under [seventeen]
5 eighteen years of age to use a tanning device. Any operator who,
6 knowing that a person is under [seventeen] eighteen years of age or
7 under circumstances where such operator should know that a person
8 is under [seventeen] eighteen years of age, allows such person to use a
9 tanning device shall be fined not more than one hundred dollars. Such
10 fine shall be payable to the municipal health department or health
11 district for the municipality in which the tanning facility is located.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To raise the minimum age of persons allowed to use a tanning device at a tanning facility from seventeen to eighteen.
