**AN ACT CONCERNING THE THRESHOLD FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION'S REVIEW OF ALTERNATIVE TREATMENT SEPTIC SYSTEMS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2018*) Notwithstanding any  
2 provision of the Public Health Code or title 22a or 25 of the general  
3 statutes, the threshold for the Department of Energy and  
4 Environmental Protection's review of alternative treatment septic  
5 systems shall be such a system with a capacity of seven thousand five  
6 hundred gallons.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
