***AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PILOT PROGRAM FOR SPEED
DETECTING CAMERAS AND CONCERNING SPEED WARNING
SIGNS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective October 1, 2018*) (a) For the purposes of this
2 section, "speed detecting camera" means a device that is designed to
3 automatically record the image of the license plate of a motor vehicle
4 that is traveling at a speed in excess of the speed limit established for a
5 highway, road, street or parking area and indicates on the recorded
6 image produced the date, time, location of the violation and the speed
7 of the motor vehicle.

8 (b) The Department of Transportation, in consultation with the
9 Office of Policy and Management and the Department of Emergency
10 Services and Public Protection shall establish a pilot program to allow
11 for not more than four municipalities to install speed detecting
12 cameras at no more than five intersections in the municipality and no
13 more than five intersections located in school zones in the
14 municipality. Municipalities shall apply to the Commissioner of

15 Transportation in the manner and form directed by the commissioner
16 for inclusion in the pilot program.

17 (c) Not later than January 1, 2020, the commissioner shall submit a
18 report on its findings regarding the pilot program and
19 recommendations to the joint standing committee of the General
20 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to transportation, in
21 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes.

22 Sec. 2. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2018*) The Commissioner of
23 Transportation shall, on Interstate 95 between the towns of Old
24 Saybrook and East Lyme, erect and maintain speed warning signs for
25 the guidance of persons traveling thereon and shall erect and maintain
26 such speed signs as approved by the Office of State Traffic
27 Administration.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a pilot program for speed detecting cameras and to erect speed warning signs on a portion of Interstate 95.
