**"AN ACT CONCERNING STUDENTS' RIGHT TO PRIVACY IN
THEIR MOBILE ELECTRONIC DEVICES."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) There is established a working
4 group to study and make recommendations concerning issues relating
5 to the search and seizure of student's personal electronic devices.

6 (b) The working group shall consist of the following members:

7 (1) The executive director of the Commission on Women, Children
8 and Seniors, or the executive director's designee;

9 (2) The Commissioner of Education, or the commissioner's designee;

10 (3) The executive director of Connecticut Legal Services, or the

11 executive director's designee;

12 (4) A representative from the Connecticut Association of Boards of
13 Education;

14 (5) A representative from the Connecticut Association of Public
15 School Superintendents;

16 (6) A representative from the Connecticut Education Association;

17 (7) A representative from the Connecticut Criminal Defense
18 Lawyers Association;

19 (8) A representative from the Office of the Chief Public Defender;

20 (9) A representative from the American Civil Liberties Union of
21 Connecticut;

22 (10) A representative from the Center for Children's Advocacy;

23 (11) A representative from the Division of Criminal Justice; and

24 (12) A representative from CTCORE-Organize Now!.

25 (c) The executive director of the Commission on Women, Children
26 and Seniors, or the executive director's designee, shall schedule the
27 first meeting of the working group, which shall be held not later than
28 sixty days after the effective date of this section.

29 (d) The members of the working group shall elect two chairpersons
30 from among the members of the working group.

31 (e) The administrative staff of the Commission on Women, Children
32 and Seniors shall serve as administrative staff of the task force.

33 (f) Not later than January 1, 2019, the working group shall submit a
34 report on its findings and recommendations to the joint standing
35 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
36 relating to education, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-

37 4a of the general statutes. The working group shall terminate on the
38 date that it submits such report or January 1, 2019, whichever is later."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
