**"AN ACT CONCERNING MINOR REVISIONS AND ADDITIONS TO
THE EDUCATION STATUTES."**

1 Strike section 1 in its entirety and renumber the remaining sections
2 and internal references accordingly

3 In line 98, insert opening and closing brackets around "2017" and
4 insert "2018" after the closing bracket

5 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
6 internal references accordingly:

7 "Sec. 501. Section 10-16v of the general statutes is repealed and the
8 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2018*):

9 (a) The Commissioner of Education, in consultation with the
10 Commissioner of Social Services, and the executive director of the
11 Commission on Women, Children and Seniors, shall establish an after
12 school committee.

13 (b) The after school committee shall be appointed by the

14 Commissioner of Education, in consultation with the Commissioner of
15 Social Services, and the executive director of the Commission on
16 Women, Children and Seniors and shall include, but not be limited to,
17 persons having expertise in after school programs, after school
18 program providers, local elected officials, members of community
19 agencies, members of the business community and professional
20 educators.

21 (c) The after school committee may report on and make
22 recommendations, including, but not be limited to, the following: (1)
23 Identification of existing state, federal and private resources to support
24 and sustain after school programs; (2) methods and practices to
25 enhance coordination and goal setting among state agencies to achieve
26 efficiencies and to encourage training and local technical assistance
27 with respect to after school programs; (3) identification of best
28 practices; (4) methods of encouraging community-based providers; (5)
29 professional development; (6) measures to address barriers to after
30 school programs; and (7) a private and public governance structure
31 that ensures sustainability for after school programs.

32 (d) The Commissioner of Education may seek and accept funding
33 from private organizations that do not receive grants or other funding
34 from the Department of Education to implement the provisions of this
35 section.

36 (e) The after school committee shall report, in accordance with
37 section 11-4a, its findings pursuant to this section to the General
38 Assembly by February 1, 2004.

39 (f) Not later than February 1, 2019, the after school committee shall
40 submit a report, and any recommendations for legislation, on how to
41 better coordinate, expand, finance and improve the quality,
42 accessibility and affordability of summer and after school
43 programming for school-age children in all settings to the joint
44 standing committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of
45 matters relating to education and appropriations, in accordance with

46 the provisions of section 11-4a."
