"AN ACT CONCERNING MINOR REVISIONS AND ADDITIONS TO THE EDUCATION STATUTES."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subdivision (2) of subsection (a) of section 10-76d of the
4 2018 supplement to the general statutes is repealed and the following
5 is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

6 (2) Not later than December 1, 2017, each local and regional board of
7 education shall (A) enroll as a provider in the state medical assistance
8 program, (B) participate in the Medicaid School Based Child Health
9 Program administered by the Department of Social Services, and (C)
10 submit billable service information electronically to the Department of
11 Social Services, or its billing agent. For each local or regional board of
12 education with a student population of less than one thousand
13 students, a cost benefit analysis may be conducted by such local or

14 regional board of education in a form prescribed by the Commissioner
 15 of Social Services to determine whether the cost to participate in the
 16 medical assistance program exceeds the revenue that would be
 17 generated for the local or regional board of education. A local or
 18 regional board of education exempted from the requirements of this
 19 subdivision after such cost benefit analysis shall complete and submit
 20 such analysis to the commissioner every three years in order to remain
 21 exempt. Not later than September 1, 2018, the commissioner of Social
 22 Services shall develop a cost benefit analysis model and determine the
 23 feasibility of directly certifying students as eligible for Medicaid
 24 benefits on behalf of a local or regional board of education."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
