"AN ACT CONCERNING MINIMUM EMPLOYEE WAGES FOR PROVIDERS OF STATE-CONTRACTED HUMAN SERVICES."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) For purposes of this section, (1)
4 "employee" means any privately employed person who provides
5 human services, including, but not limited to, any person who receives
6 compensation pursuant to a contractual arrangement with a private
7 human services provider who is not directly employed by such
8 provider, and (2) "human services" means any of the services
9 administered by the Departments of Correction, Housing, Public
10 Health, Social Services, Children and Families, Developmental
11 Services, Rehabilitation Services and Mental Health and Addiction
12 Services, the Office of Early Childhood and the Judicial Department
13 that involve direct care of eligible persons, including, but not limited

14 to, medical services, mental health and addiction treatment, nutrition
 15 and housing assistance, services for children, persons with intellectual
 16 and developmental disabilities and residential and habilitative
 17 services.

18 (b) The Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management shall
 19 allocate available funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, to
 20 provide a one per cent cost-of-living adjustment to employees who
 21 provide human services. The secretary may reduce rates for any
 22 private provider of human services that receives such funds to provide
 23 such cost-of-living adjustment to employees but fails to provide such
 24 adjustment.

25 Sec. 2. (*Effective from passage*) The sum of eighteen million dollars is
 26 appropriated to the Office of Policy and Management, from the
 27 General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, for the purpose
 28 of providing a one per cent cost-of-living adjustment to employees
 29 who provide human services as such employees and human services
 30 are defined in section 1 of this act."
