**"AN ACT CONCERNING CHANGES TO THE STATE PERSONNEL ACT."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 5-218 of the general statutes is  
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*  
5 *October 1, 2018*):

6 (b) The Commissioner of Administrative Services shall give public  
7 notice of such examinations for positions in the classified service at  
8 least [two weeks] six business days in advance by posting, or causing  
9 to be posted, an appropriate notice [on the bulletin board maintained  
10 in or near the quarters of the Department of Administrative Services  
11 and] on the Internet web site of the department and by submitting the

12 notice to the director of the state employment service. Such notice shall  
 13 set forth the time and place of the examination and shall be  
 14 accompanied by a copy of the official description of the position, and  
 15 provide the work location, salary and weights to be given for the  
 16 weighted parts of the examination, if applicable, provided once such  
 17 notice has been given, the weights established in the notice for the  
 18 weighted parts of the examination shall not be altered in any manner.

19 Sec. 2. Section 5-221a of the general statutes is repealed and the  
 20 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2018*):

21 An applicant for employment or an employee in the classified  
 22 service may appeal the rejection of such applicant's or employee's  
 23 application, in writing, to the Commissioner of Administrative  
 24 Services not later than [twelve] six business days after the [mailing]  
 25 transmittal of such rejection notice by providing supplementary  
 26 information on qualifications as may be necessary. Such applicant or  
 27 employee may request a review of such rejection by an independent  
 28 human resource professional who shall render a final decision on the  
 29 applicant's or employee's appeal within fifteen days thereafter.

30 Sec. 3. Section 5-243 of the general statutes is repealed and the  
 31 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2018*):

32 Resignations from the classified service [and reemployment of  
 33 former state employees who have retired but who have not reached  
 34 the mandatory retirement age] shall be subject to regulations issued by  
 35 the Commissioner of Administrative Services."
