Rep. Fleischmann, A. 18 opened the meeting and asked for a moment of silence for the 17th deaths at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School, Parkland, FL.

Rep. Fleischmann, A. 18 asked if there were any comments from leadership.

Rep. Fleischmann, A. 18 indicated that Sen. Slossberg, G. S14 would be arriving late and that the committee begin the conversation on the bills for action before the committee.

Rep. Fleischmann, A. 18 asked for a motion to JFS to the floor [Substitute for H.B. No. 5167](#) (RAISED) (File No. 121) AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT A TOWN MAY DEPOSIT INTO A NONLAPSING ACCOUNT FOR UNEXPENDED EDUCATION FUNDS. (ED)

Rep. Sanchez, R. 25 offered the motion and it was seconded by Sen. Boucher, T. S26.

Rep. Lavielle, G. 143 asked if the members had any objections to creating a consent calendar. Hearing none, a consent calendar was established.
