Monday, March 19, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 11:39 by Chairman, Rep. Fleischmann A. 018 and immediately recessed.

The meeting was reconvened at 12:00 by Sen. Slossberg, G. S14.

Sen. Slossberg, G. S14 asked if there were any comments from leadership. Seeing none, she moved to part three of the agenda.

Sen. Slossberg, G. S14 asked for a motion to JF to the floor [S.B. No. 452](#) (RAISED).

Rep. Fleischmann, A. 18 stated that Bill 452 is meant to be fully inclusive of every instance of genocide including Native Americans and African Americans on the Middle Passage (as examples).

Rep. Currey, J. 11 offered the motion and it was seconded by Rep. Belsito, S. 53.

Rep. Lavielle, G. 143 motioned to have the bill added to the consent calendar and it was.

Sen. Slossberg, G. S14 asked for a motion to JF to the floor [S.B. No. 456](#) (RAISED).

Rep. McCarthy Vahey, C. 133 offered the motion and it was seconded by Rep. Candelaria, J. 95.

Rep. Lavielle, G. 143 motioned to have the bill added to the consent calendar and it was.

Sen. Slossberg, G. S14 asked for a motion to JF to the floor [H.B. No. 5450](#) (RAISED).

Rep. Sanchez, R. 25 offered the motion and it was seconded by Rep. Lopes, R. 24.

Rep. Lavielle, G. 143 motioned to have the bill added to the consent calendar and it was.

Sen. Slossberg, G. S14 asked for a motion to JF to the floor [H.B. No. 5448](#) (RAISED).

Rep. Lavielle, G. 143 stated in regards to Bill 5448 that she was disappointed that a bill needed to be created for institutions to regularly assess the outcomes of their programs.

Rep. Sanchez, R. 25 offered the motion and it was seconded by Rep. McCarthy Vahey, C. 133.

Rep. Lavielle, G. 143 motioned to have the bill added to the consent calendar and it was.

Sen. Slossberg, G. S14 asked for a motion to JF to the floor [S.B. No. 459](#) (RAISED).

Rep. Fleischmann, A. 18 offered the motion and it was seconded by Rep. Candelaria, J. 95.

Rep. Lavielle, G. 143 motioned to have the bill added to the consent calendar and it was.

Sen. Slossberg, G. S14 asked for a motion to JF to the floor [S.B. No. 183](#) (RAISED).

Rep. Fleischmann, A. 18 offered the motion and it was seconded by Rep. Candelaria, J. 95.

Rep. Lavielle, G. 143 motioned to have the bill added to the consent calendar and it was.

Sen. Slossberg, G. S14 asked for a motion to JF to the floor [H.B. No. 5169](#) (RAISED).

Rep. Sanchez, R. 25 offered the motion and it was seconded by Rep. Fleischmann, A. 18.

Sen. Boucher, T. S26 stated that clarifying language is still in process for HB 5169 so that relatives of a child providing child care also go through the same background check as other providers.

Sen. Slossberg, G. S14 stated that providers would be checked against the Child Abuse Registry, the National Sex Offenders list, and the state criminal background check.

Rep. Fleischmann, A. 18 stated that the House agrees with this aspect of HB 5169 and will joint screen regarding the three layer background check which replaces the FBI background check.

Rep. Lavielle, G. 143 stated that both sides of the aisle agree on the needed language changes to HB 5169.

Rep. Lavielle, G. 143 motioned to have the bill added to the consent calendar and it was.

Sen. Slossberg, G. S14 asked for a motion to JF to the floor [H.B. No. 5336](#) (RAISED).

Rep. Fleischmann, A. 18 offered the motion and it was seconded by Rep. Sanchez, R. 25.

Rep. Lavielle, G. 143 motioned to have the bill added to the consent calendar and it was.

Sen. Slossberg, G. S14 called the clerk to read the consent calendar.

The consent calendar was voted on.

A roll call vote occurred with the total number of voting-36; those voting Yea-36; those voting No-00; absent and not voting-00.

The meeting was recessed at 12:13 PM, adjourning at 4:00 PM.
