Honorable Senator Miner, Senator Kennedy, Representative Demicco, and distinguished members of the committee,

On behalf of the Connecticut Chapter of the Sierra Club, I am writing to request that you vote in favor of Senate Bill Number 103, An Act Concerning Hydraulic Fracturing Waste in Connecticut. We support a permanent ban on toxic, radioactive fracking waste from being imported into Connecticut for the purposes of disposal, storage, or use.

Senate Bill 103 has a chance of changing state law and creating a permanent ban of waste from one process only, hydraulic fracturing from gas wells. Connecticut will continue to pass more comprehensive local bans, as well. Thirty six towns now have ordinances, and over fifteen more are pending.

We appreciate the committee for taking up this important and timely issue.
