The Committee on Children reported through REP. URBAN of the 43rd Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT EXTENDING THE REPORTING DEADLINE OF THE TASK FORCE TO STUDY VOLUNTARY ADMISSION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (f) of section 1 of special act 17-6 is amended to
2 read as follows (*Effective from passage*):

3 (f) Not later than [February 1, 2018] January 1, 2019, the task force
4 shall submit a report on its findings and recommendations to the
5 Governor, speaker of the House of Representatives, president pro
6 tempore of the Senate, minority leader of the House of
7 Representatives, minority leader of the Senate and the joint standing
8 committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
9 relating to appropriations, children, education, human services,
10 insurance and public health, in accordance with the provisions of
11 section 11-4a of the general statutes. The task force shall provide
12 additional information regarding its findings and recommendations at
13 the request of the Governor or a member of the General Assembly. The

14 task force shall terminate on July 1, [2018] 2019.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	<i>from passage</i>	SA 17-6, Sec. 1(f)

SA 17-6 established a task force to study the voluntary services program operated by the Department of Children and Families.

The bill extends the deadline for the task force to issue its report to various committees of the General Assembly from February 1, 2018 to January 1, 2019. This date alteration has no fiscal impact.

Section 2-15b of the CGS prohibits transportation allowances for those members traveling to or from any meeting of such task force.
