House Bill No. 5555

*House of Representatives, April 16, 2018*

The Committee on Judiciary reported through REP. TONG of the 147th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the bill ought to pass.

## ***AN ACT CONCERNING THE YOUTH VIOLENCE INITIATIVE.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Judicial Department shall  
2 include the town of Waterbury in the list of towns to which the  
3 department gives a Youth Violence Initiative grant under section 1 of  
4 public act 17-2 of the June special session, as amended by section 16 of  
5 public act 17-4 of the June special session.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

**Explanation**

The bill adds Waterbury to the list of recipient towns under the Youth Violence Initiative program and results in a revenue loss to the cities who currently receive Youth Violence funds - Bridgeport, Hartford, and New Haven. As the bill does not increase the appropriation for this account, the bill does not result in a fiscal impact to the state.
