The Committee on Finance, Revenue and Bonding reported through SEN. FONFARA of the 1st Dist. and SEN. FRANTZ, L. of the 36th Dist., Chairpersons of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF STATE TAX POLICIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Revenue
2 Services shall study the tax policies of the state to identify legislative
3 changes that may be made to improve the business climate and
4 economic opportunities in the state. The commissioner may consult
5 with any individuals, businesses and state agencies the commissioner
6 deems necessary or appropriate to accomplish the purposes of the
7 study. Not later than January 1, 2019, the commissioner shall submit a
8 report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general
9 statutes, on the commissioner's findings and recommendations to the
10 joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance
11 of matters relating to finance, revenue and bonding.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
