The Committee on Finance, Revenue and Bonding reported through SEN. FONFARA of the 1st Dist. and SEN. FRANTZ, L. of the 36th Dist., Chairpersons of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the bill ought to pass.

***AN ACT CONCERNING ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT BONDING AND
A STUDY OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND WORKFORCE
TRAINING NEEDS OF THE STATE.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Secretary of the Office of Policy
2 and Management shall, in consultation with the Commissioner of
3 Economic and Community Development, conduct a study to identify
4 the economic development and technical skills workforce training
5 needs of the state. Such report shall include, but not be limited to,
6 recommendations for specific programmatic changes and initiatives to
7 address such needs and corresponding bond authorization amounts
8 deemed necessary to accomplish such changes and implement such
9 initiatives. Not later than January 1, 2019, the secretary shall submit
10 such report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the
11 general statutes, to the joint standing committees of the General
12 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to finance, revenue
13 and bonding and commerce.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
