Explanation

The amendment eliminates the bill's potential cost to UConn Health Center as the signage requirements in Section 2 no longer apply to any UConn Health facilities. The facility fee clarifications in Section 1, which are also changed in the amendment, do not have a fiscal impact to UConn Health, or to state or municipal health plans, as in the corrected fiscal note to the underlying bill.
