

**Proposed Substitute  
Bill No. 489**

LCO No. 3136

**AN ACT DESIGNATING VARIOUS DAYS AND WEEKS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 10-29a of the 2018 supplement to  
2 the general statutes is amended by adding subdivisions (83) to (86),  
3 inclusive, as follows (*Effective from passage*):

4 (NEW) (83) The Governor shall proclaim September eighth of each  
5 year to be Cable Technician Recognition Day to honor cable  
6 technicians. Suitable exercises may be held in the State Capitol and  
7 elsewhere as the Governor designates for the observance of the day.

8 (NEW) (84) The Governor shall proclaim November twelfth of each  
9 year to be Military Spouses' Day to acknowledge the significant  
10 contributions, support, and sacrifices of spouses of members of the  
11 Armed Forces. Suitable exercises may be held in the State Capitol and  
12 elsewhere as the Governor designates for the observance of the day.

13 (NEW) (85) The Governor shall proclaim November thirtieth of each  
14 year to be Sikh Genocide Remembrance Day to remember the lives lost  
15 on November 30, 1984, during the Sikh Genocide. Suitable exercises  
16 may be held in the State Capitol and elsewhere as the Governor  
17 designates for the observance of the day.

18 (NEW) (86) The Governor shall proclaim the fourth week in  
19 February of each year to be Eating Disorders Awareness Week to  
20 heighten public awareness of the associated presentation and available

21 treatments for eating disorders. Suitable exercises may be held in the  
22 State Capitol and elsewhere as the Governor designates for the  
23 observance of the week.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
