REASONS FOR BILL:

Currently, DMHAS is responsible for an annual report on the status of the availability of substance use disorder treatment programs for pregnant women and women with children. DMHAS is also responsible for developing, implementing and updating a comprehensive plan for the prevention, treatment and reduction of alcohol and drug abuse problems in consultation with key stakeholders every three years. This legislation would combine the reporting requirements contained in these two statutes related to substance use into one report once every three years.
