"AN ACT CONCERNING FIREARMS IN STATE PARKS."

1 In line 5, after the period, insert the following: "Any person who
2 holds such a valid permit and who carries such pistol or revolver in a
3 state park shall present such permit to any conservation officer, special
4 conservation officer, patrolman appointed pursuant to section 26-5 of
5 the general statutes or police officer, as defined in section 7-294a of the
6 general statutes, upon request."

7 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
8 internal references accordingly:

9 "Sec. 501. Section 29-28 of the general statutes is amended by adding
10 subsection (g) as follows (*Effective from passage*):

11 (NEW) (g) Any person issued a permit to carry a pistol or revolver
12 pursuant to this section shall present such permit to any police officer,
13 as defined in section 7-294a, conservation officer, special conservation

14 officer, or patrolman appointed pursuant to section 26-5, upon
15 request."
