***"RESOLUTION PROPOSING A STATE CONSTITUTIONAL  
AMENDMENT TO PERMIT EARLY VOTING."***

1      Strike everything after the resolving clause and substitute the  
2      following in lieu thereof:

3      "That the following be proposed as an amendment to the  
4      Constitution of the State, which, when approved and adopted in the  
5      manner provided by the Constitution, shall, to all intents and  
6      purposes, become a part thereof:

7      Section 7 of article sixth of the Constitution is amended to read as  
8      follows:

9      Sec. 7. The general assembly may provide by law for voting in the  
10     choice of any officer to be elected or upon any question to be voted on  
11     at an election by qualified voters of the state who are unable to appear  
12     at the polling place on the day of election because of absence from the

13 city or town of which they are inhabitants or because of sickness or  
14 physical disability or because the tenets of their religion forbid secular  
15 activity, provided the vote cast by each such qualified voter shall be  
16 included in an audit of the results of such choice or such question.

17 RESOLVED: That the foregoing proposed amendment to the  
18 Constitution be continued to the next session of the General Assembly  
19 elected at the general election to be held on November 6, 2018, and  
20 published with the laws passed at the present session, or be presented  
21 to the electors at the general election to be held on November 6, 2018,  
22 whichever the case may be, according to article sixth of the  
23 amendments to the Constitution. The designation of said proposed  
24 amendment to be used on the ballots at such election shall be "Shall the  
25 Constitution of the State be amended to require that absentee ballots be  
26 included in audits of election, primary and referendum results?"
