"AN ACT CONCERNING CLIMATE CHANGE PLANNING AND RESILIENCY."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) Upon acquiring any interest in or
4 ownership of a certain piece or parcel of land located at 100 and 101
5 Lee Road, Griswold, Connecticut and more particularly described as
6 follows:

7 "That certain piece or parcel of land known as 100 and 101 Lee
8 Road, Griswold, Connecticut, with the buildings thereon standing,
9 situated in the Town of Griswold County of New London and State of
10 Connecticut, and bounded and described as follows:

11 NORTHERLY by land now or formerly of Guiseppe Rubbons and
12 Domenic Sarazin;

13 EASTERLY by land now or formerly of James Dowings et. al., and

14 by the Highway;

15 SOUTHERLY by land now or formerly of the heirs of Elias Lord,
16 and

17 WESTERLY by land now or formerly of the heirs of Elias Lord, and
18 land now or formerly of Otis Horton, and the Highway

19 Reference is made to a warrantee deed recorded at Volume 33, page
20 563 of the Griswold Land Records."

21 The Department of Administrative Services shall immediately
22 transfer the care, custody and control of said piece or parcel of land to
23 the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection for the sole
24 purpose of incorporating all of said land into the Pachaug State
25 Forest."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
