**"AN ACT CONCERNING MINOR REVISIONS AND ADDITIONS TO  
THE EDUCATION STATUTES."**

1 Strike section 3 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

2 "Sec. 3. Subsection (d) of section 10-16b of the 2018 supplement to  
3 the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu  
4 thereof (*Effective July 1, 2018*):

5 (d) The State Board of Education shall make available curriculum  
6 materials and such other materials as may assist local and regional  
7 boards of education in developing instructional programs pursuant to  
8 this section. The State Board of Education, within available  
9 appropriations and utilizing available resource materials, shall assist  
10 and encourage local and regional boards of education to include: (1)  
11 Holocaust and genocide education and awareness; (2) the historical  
12 events surrounding the Great Famine in Ireland; (3) African-American

13 history; (4) Puerto Rican history; (5) Native American history; (6)  
 14 personal financial management, including, but not limited to, financial  
 15 literacy as developed in the plan provided under section 10-16pp; (7)  
 16 training in cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the use of automatic  
 17 external defibrillators; (8) labor history and law, including organized  
 18 labor, the collective bargaining process, existing legal protections in the  
 19 workplace, the history and economics of free market capitalism and  
 20 entrepreneurialism, and the role of labor and capitalism in the  
 21 development of the American and world economies; [and] (9) topics  
 22 approved by the state board upon the request of local or regional  
 23 boards of education as part of the program of instruction offered  
 24 pursuant to subsection (a) of this section; and (10) instruction relating  
 25 to the Safe Haven Act, sections 17a-57 to 17a-61, inclusive."

26 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
 27 internal references accordingly:

28 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2018*) The Department of Children  
 29 and Families shall provide instructional materials relating to the Safe  
 30 Haven Act, sections 17a-57 to 17a-61, inclusive, of the general statutes,  
 31 to (1) a local or regional board of education, upon request of such  
 32 board, and (2) the State Board of Education, not later than October 1,  
 33 2018, for the purpose of assisting the state board in meeting its  
 34 responsibility of making available curriculum materials pursuant to  
 35 subsection (d) of section 10-16b of the general statutes, as amended by  
 36 this act."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
