**"AN ACT CONCERNING NEWLY DISCOVERED EVIDENCE."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 53a-192a of the 2018 supplement to the general  
4 statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof  
5 (*Effective July 1, 2018*):

6 (a) A person is guilty of trafficking in persons when such person (1)  
7 knowingly compels or induces another person to engage in conduct  
8 involving sexual contact with one or more third persons, or provide  
9 labor or services that such person has a legal right to refrain from  
10 providing, by means of (A) the use of force against such other person  
11 or a third person, or by the threat of use of force against such other  
12 person or a third person, (B) fraud, or (C) coercion, as provided in  
13 section 53a-192, (2) compels or induces another person who is under  
14 eighteen years of age to engage in conduct involving sexual contact  
15 with one or more third persons that constitutes sexual contact for

16 which such third person may be charged with a criminal offense, or (3)  
17 otherwise commits an act that constitutes sex trafficking. For the  
18 purposes of this subsection, "sexual contact" means any contact with  
19 the intimate parts of another person, and "sex trafficking" means the  
20 recruitment, harboring, transportation or provision of a person for the  
21 purpose of engaging in sexual conduct with another person [for a fee]  
22 in exchange for anything of value.

23 (b) Trafficking in persons is a class A felony."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Sec. 501	July 1, 2018	53a-192a
