"AN ACT CONCERNING THE LEGISLATIVE COMMISSIONERS' RECOMMENDATIONS FOR TECHNICAL AND MINOR REVISIONS TO STATUTES CONCERNING MILITARY AND VETERANS' AFFAIRS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsections (b) to (d), inclusive, of section 27-39 of the
4 general statutes are repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
5 thereof (*Effective July 1, 2018*):

6 (b) The Adjutant General is charged with the responsibility for the
7 use, maintenance, security and leasing of all military facilities and
8 other military property under the provisions for such use imposed by
9 the statutes. Each military facility shall be under the charge of a
10 commissioned officer, designated by the Adjutant General. Each
11 application for the lease or use of such facility shall be made to the

12 Adjutant General, who shall approve or disapprove such application
13 and so advise the applicant. Prior to any such approval, each applicant
14 for lease or use of such facility shall furnish a certificate of insurance or
15 self-insurance indemnifying the state and federal governments against
16 any bodily injury to persons or damage to property. Any cost of such
17 certificate shall be in addition to any other cost incurred as a result of
18 such lease or use. Except as provided in subsection (e) of this section,
19 the Adjutant General shall limit the lease or use of military facilities to
20 (1) military [and] organizations, including youth military
21 organizations, (2) nonprofit organizations, (3) organizations receiving
22 state aid, and (4) governmental agencies. Proceeds from the lease of
23 military facilities shall be paid to the Adjutant General, who shall
24 promptly transmit such proceeds, except proceeds received from the
25 lease of certain military facilities pursuant to subsection (e) of this
26 section, to the State Treasurer for deposit in the military facilities
27 account established under subsection (f) of this section. The Adjutant
28 General shall, in military facilities where space is available, assign
29 space to veterans' service organizations for their joint uses, subject to
30 the regulations concerning military facilities. Units of the armed forces
31 of the state and veterans' organizations jointly utilizing military
32 facilities shall be allowed the use of the drill shed and such other
33 common areas of the facility.

34 (c) Nothing in this chapter shall be construed as allowing the lease
35 or use of, or assignment of space in, any military facility (1) on the drill
36 night of any active military organization stationed in the facility or in a
37 manner that conflicts with the military usage of the facility, (2) at a
38 reduced rate, except as provided in subdivision (2) of subsection (d) of
39 this section, or (3) in a manner that conflicts with federal military
40 regulations or the use of the facility for military purposes. In no case
41 shall any lease approved by the Adjutant General pursuant to
42 subsection (b) of this section permit subleasing.

43 (d) (1) The Adjutant General may allow lease or use of any military
44 facility, at a cost not exceeding the actual operating cost of such facility
45 during the period of such lease or use, to [(1)] (A) any public or private

46 nonprofit elementary or secondary school or any public institution of
 47 higher education for purposes of athletic events with respect to which
 48 no admission is charged, [(2)] (B) the American Red Cross for purposes
 49 of blood supply programs, [(3)] (C) any local, state or federal
 50 governmental agency, [(4)] (D) any agricultural or other association
 51 that receives state aid, or [(5)] (E) any military organization, except as
 52 provided in subdivision (2) of this subsection.

53 (2) The Adjutant General may allow use of any military facility, at
 54 no cost, to any youth military organization."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
