**"AN ACT CONCERNING GHOST GUNS."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2018*) The Connecticut  
4 Sentencing Commission established pursuant to section 54-300 of the  
5 general statutes shall evaluate and track the outcomes of prosecutions  
6 of crimes committed with the use of a firearm, as defined in section  
7 53a-3 of the general statutes. Such evaluation and tracking shall  
8 include all cases prosecuted in any part of the years 2012 to 2017,  
9 inclusive, and annually thereafter, but need not include any ongoing

10 prosecution. Such evaluation and tracking shall detail crimes  
 11 committed with the use of a firearm, whether possessed legally or  
 12 illegally, as well as conviction rates and the penalties and sentences  
 13 associated with the conviction of persons prosecuted for any such  
 14 crimes.

15 (b) Not later than January 1, 2019, and annually thereafter, the  
 16 commission shall report, in accordance with the provisions of section  
 17 11-4a of the general statutes, the results of such evaluation and  
 18 tracking to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly  
 19 having cognizance of matters relating to the judiciary."
