Proposed H.B. No. 5001 REP. DILLON, 92nd DIST. 'AN ACT ESTABLISHING A FEE ON VIRTUAL CURRENCY TRANSACTIONS', to impose a fee on transactions involving virtual currency.

Proposed H.B. No. 5002 REP. ZIOBRON, 34th DIST. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE OCCUPANCY TAX ON CERTAIN BED AND BREAKFAST ESTABLISHMENTS', to exempt bed and breakfast establishments with five or fewer guest rooms from the occupancy tax.
