**Proposed H.B. No. 5122 REP. MCCARTY, 38th DIST. 'AN ACT CONCERNING FUNDS FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF HARKNESS MEMORIAL STATE PARK'**, to make funds received from marriage ceremonies performed at Harkness Memorial State Park available for maintenance of the park instead of diverting them to the General Fund.

**Proposed H.B. No. 5123 REP. FLEISCHMANN, 18th DIST. 'AN ACT RESTORING EDUCATION COST-SHARING GRANT FUNDING TO TOWNS'**, to restore education cost-sharing grant funding to those towns whose grants were reduced by the executive branch.

'AN ACT CONCERNING THE SEWAGE SPILL RIGHT-TO-KNOW ACT AND EXPANDING CONTINUING EDUCATION PROGRAMS FOR WASTEWATER OPERATORS'**, to establish a time frame and additional methodology for the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection to notify the public of unanticipated sewage spills and to require continuing education requirements for wastewater treatment facility operators.

'AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE OFFICE OF HIGHER EDUCATION'**, to make permissive the requirement that the Office of Higher Education develop a strategic plan to ensure racial and ethnic diversity at public institutions of higher education.

**Proposed H.B. No. 5137 REP. JOHNSON, 49th DIST. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE RENTER'S REBATE PROGRAM'**, to eliminate the requirement that the Office of Policy and Management withhold or reduce state financial assistance provided to municipalities whose renters received grant payments under the renter's rebate program, or, in the alternative, require the Office of Policy and Management to withhold or reduce such state financial assistance from each municipality in this state.

**Proposed H.B. No. 5141 REP. BELSITO, 53rd DIST. 'AN ACT EXEMPTING MOTOR VEHICLES FIVE OR LESS MODEL YEARS OF AGE FROM EMISSION INSPECTIONS AND ELIMINATING THE ADDITIONAL FEE CHARGED FOR THE REGISTRATION OF NEW MOTOR VEHICLES THAT ARE EXEMPT FROM EMISSION INSPECTIONS'**, to exempt motor vehicles five or less model years of age, instead of four or less model years of age, from emission inspections and to eliminate the additional registration fee charged for new motor vehicles that are exempt from emission inspections.
