H.B. No. 5142 (RAISED) AGING. 'AN ACT CONCERNING NURSING HOME SERVICES', to require the Commissioner of Social Services to study whether nursing homes are meeting the state's residents' need for long-term institutional care.

H.B. No. 5143 (RAISED) AGING. 'AN ACT LOWERING THE AGE OF ELIGIBILITY FOR PROPERTY TAX RELIEF FOR ELDERLY PERSONS', to lower the age an elderly person must be to obtain available property tax relief.

'AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH'S RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING REVISIONS TO THE GENERAL STATUTES CONCERNING MUNICIPAL HEALTH AUTHORITIES AND DISTRICT DEPARTMENTS OF HEALTH', to implement the recommendations of the Department of Public Health regarding revisions to the general statutes concerning municipal health authorities and district departments of health.

H.B. No. 5151 (RAISED) PUBLIC HEALTH. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH'S RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING CONNECTICUT'S SAFE DRINKING WATER', to implement the Department of Public Health's recommendations regarding Connecticut's safe drinking water.

H.B. No. 5152 (RAISED) PUBLIC HEALTH. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE PRESCRIBING OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES USED IN MEDICATION-ASSISTED TREATMENT OF SUBSTANCE USE DISORDERS THROUGH THE USE OF TELEHEALTH', to permit the prescribing of controlled substances used in medication-assisted treatment of substance use disorders through the use of telehealth services.

H.B. No. 5153 (RAISED) PUBLIC HEALTH. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENTAL SERVICES' RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING GUARDIANSHIP ASSESSMENTS', to implement the recommendations of the Department of Developmental Services regarding guardianship assessments.

REF. PUBLIC HEALTH

H.B. No. 5154 (RAISED) PUBLIC HEALTH. 'AN ACT CONCERNING WATER USAGE AND CONSERVATION DURING DROUGHT CONDITIONS', to require the Water Planning Council to report to the General Assembly regarding its review of state and local processes and authorities for the issuance of drought advisory, watch, warning or emergency and any attendant water use restrictions.

H.B. No. 5155 (RAISED) PUBLIC HEALTH. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENTAL SERVICES' RECOMMENDATION REGARDING WAIVER OF LICENSING FEES FOR PRIVATE PROVIDERS', to implement the recommendations of the Department of Developmental Services regarding waiver of licensing fees for private providers.

H.B. No. 5156 (RAISED) PUBLIC HEALTH. 'AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH'S RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING ACCESS TO A COPY OF AN ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF PATERNITY', to implement the recommendations of the Department of Public Health regarding access to a copy of an acknowledgment of paternity form.

H.B. No. 5157 (RAISED) PUBLIC HEALTH. 'AN ACT REQUIRING THE INSTALLATION OF VIDEO CAMERAS IN THE ROOMS OF NONVERBAL NURSING HOME RESIDENTS', to ensure the safety of nonverbal residents of nursing homes.

H.B. No. 5158 (RAISED) PUBLIC HEALTH. 'AN ACT REQUIRING FOOD ALLERGY TRAINING IN RESTAURANTS', to ensure food allergy awareness in the restaurant industry.

H.B. No. 5159 (RAISED) PUBLIC HEALTH. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENTAL SERVICES REGARDING OVERSIGHT OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE AND END-OF-LIFE PLANNING', to implement the recommendations of the Department of Developmental Services regarding oversight of emergency medical care and end-of-life planning.

H.B. No. 5160 (RAISED) PUBLIC HEALTH. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE DONATION OF BLOOD BY MINORS', to allow persons sixteen years of age and older to donate blood.

H.B. No. 5161 (RAISED) PUBLIC HEALTH. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH'S RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING SEAT BELTS', to implement the recommendations of the Department of Public Health to require the use of seat belts in all positions of a vehicle.

H.B. No. 5162 (RAISED) PUBLIC HEALTH. 'AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY OF FUNDING FOR MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES', to require a study of funding for mental health services in the state to ensure that children with mental health needs are admitted to facilities that can provide appropriate treatment.
