H.B. No. 5167 (RAISED) EDUCATION. 'AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT A BOARD OF EDUCATION MAY DEPOSIT INTO A NONLAPSING ACCOUNT FOR UNEXPENDED EDUCATION FUNDS', to increase the amount of unexpended funds that a board of education is allowed to deposit into a nonlapsing account at the end of the fiscal year.

H.B. No. 5168 (RAISED) EDUCATION. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE CREATION OF THE SUMMER LEARNING GRANT PROGRAM', to create a summer learning grant program.

REF. EDUCATION

H.B. No. 5169 (RAISED) EDUCATION. 'AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE OFFICE OF EARLY CHILDHOOD', to implement the recommendations of the Office of Early Childhood.

REF. EDUCATION

H.B. No. 5170 (RAISED) EDUCATION. 'AN ACT CONCERNING STUDENTS' RIGHT TO PRIVACY IN THEIR MOBILE ELECTRONIC DEVICES', to prohibit a school employee from taking custody of or searching a student's mobile electronic device except in certain circumstances.

H.B. No. 5171 (RAISED) EDUCATION. 'AN ACT PROHIBITING THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH FROM MAKING RESCISSIONS OR OTHER REDUCTIONS TO THE EDUCATION COST SHARING GRANT DURING THE FISCAL YEAR', to prohibit the Governor from making rescissions to a town's education cost sharing grant during the fiscal year.

H.B. No. 5172 (RAISED) GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS. 'AN ACT CONCERNING STATE AGENCY DATA MANAGEMENT AND PROCESSES, THE TRANSMITTAL OF TOWN PROPERTY ASSESSMENT INFORMATION AND THE SUSPENSION OF CERTAIN REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS', to increase access to data by executive branch agencies by codifying the provisions of Executive Order 39, to require the Office of Policy and Management to establish and oversee a state-wide process improvement initiative, to require towns to transmit certain property assessment information to their regional council of governments or the Office of Policy and Management and to permit state agencies to suspend regulatory requirements for paper or facsimile submission of documents or data.

H.B. No. 5173 (RAISED) GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS. 'AN ACT PROTECTING THE PRIVACY OF VOTERS', to limit the scope of voter registration information available to certain entities and prohibit certain uses of such information.

H.B. No. 5174 (RAISED) GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS. 'AN ACT RESTRICTING LOBBYING BY FORMER STATE EMPLOYEES', to impose a one-year moratorium on lobbying by former state employees.

H.B. No. 5175 (RAISED) GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS. 'AN ACT CONCERNING APPEALS UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT', to permit the Freedom of Information Commission to grant relief from vexatious requesters to public agencies.

H.B. No. 5176 (RAISED) GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS. 'AN ACT PROTECTING MUNICIPAL POLICE OFFICERS AND THEIR FAMILIES', to prohibit disclosure of voter registration information that may place municipal police officers or their families at risk.

REF. GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS

H.B. No. 5177 (RAISED) GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS. 'AN ACT CONCERNING EMPLOYEE NOTIFICATION OF REQUESTS MADE UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT', to expand the requirement for notification to public agency employees of requests made for their personnel, medical or other similar files.

H.B. No. 5178 (RAISED) GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS. 'AN ACT REQUIRING EXECUTIVE AND LEGISLATIVE REVIEW OF CERTAIN QUASI-PUBLIC AGENCY CONTRACTS AND AN ANNUAL REVIEW OF EACH QUASI-PUBLIC AGENCY', to increase executive and legislative oversight of quasi-public agency contracts by requiring the submission of certain contracts to the Attorney General and relevant legislative committee and submission of an annual report to such committee.

Proposed H.B. No. 5179 REP. CURREY, 11th DIST. 'AN ACT WAIVING THE PROBATE COURT FILING FEE FOR CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS REQUESTING A CHANGE OF NAME', to eliminate the Probate Court filing fee associated with a petition to change one's name when the petitioner is requesting the change of name in connection to his or her marriage.

REF. JUDICIARY

H.B. No. 5180 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE APPRAISAL OF CERTAIN RENTAL INCOME-PRODUCING REAL PROPERTY', to remove the requirement that an assessor or board of assessors consider the capitalization of net income based on market rent for a similar property when appraising certain real property used primarily for the purpose of producing rental income in order to determine the present true and actual value of such property.

REF. PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

H.B. No. 5181 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT EXTENDING THE MUNICIPAL REVALUATION DEADLINE FOR THE TOWN OF WILTON BY ONE YEAR', to extend the municipal revaluation deadline for the town of Wilton by one year.

REF. PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

H.B. No. 5182 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE ASSESSMENT OF CERTAIN FEES BY BUILDING OFFICIALS', to require building officials in certain municipalities to establish and assess a fee for the commencement of certain work without a necessary permit.

REF. PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

H.B. No. 5183 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY OF THE PLANNING, DEVELOPMENT AND FINANCING OF MUNICIPAL ENTERTAINMENT DISTRICTS', to require the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management to conduct a study concerning the planning, development and financing of municipal entertainment districts.

H.B. No. 5184 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT PERMITTING THE AMENDMENT OF MUNICIPAL CHARTERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF MODIFYING BUDGET ADOPTION DATES', to permit the amendment of municipal charters for the purpose of modifying budget adoption dates.
