H.B. No. 5517 (RAISED) GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS. 'AN ACT CONCERNING EXECUTIVE BRANCH DATA MANAGEMENT AND PROCESSES', to increase access to data by executive branch agencies by codifying the provisions of Executive Order 39, to create a Connecticut Board of Data Analysis Technology Advisory Board, to require the Office of Policy and Management to establish and oversee a state-wide process improvement initiative, to require towns to transmit certain property assessment information to their regional council of governments or the Office of Policy and Management and to permit state agencies to suspend regulatory requirements for paper or facsimile submission of documents or data.

H.B. No. 5518 (RAISED) GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS. 'AN ACT PROTECTING THE CITIZENS' ELECTION FUND', to ensure the amount of funds in the Citizens' Election Fund is sufficient to provide grants to each qualified candidate committee under the Citizens' Election Program.

REF. GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS

H.B. No. 5519 (RAISED) GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS. 'AN ACT ELIMINATING THE CITIZENS' ELECTION PROGRAM', to eliminate the Citizens' Election Program.

REF. GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS

H.B. No. 5520 (RAISED) GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS. 'AN ACT CONCERNING CERTAIN EXPENDITURES OF CANDIDATE COMMITTEES PARTICIPATING IN THE CITIZENS' ELECTION PROGRAM', to limit to one thousand dollars, in the aggregate, certain expenditures made by candidate committees under the Citizens' Election Program.

REF. GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS

H.B. No. 5521 (RAISED) GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE FIRST FIVE PLUS PROGRAM AND POLITICAL CONTRIBUTIONS', to subject participants and prospective participants in the first five plus program to the same prohibitions as state contractors and prospective state contractors with regard to political contributions.

REF. GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS

H.B. No. 5522 (RAISED) GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS. 'AN ACT RESTORING THE CITIZENS' ELECTION PROGRAM, CONCERNING THE STATE ELECTIONS ENFORCEMENT COMMISSION AND REGARDING DISCLOSURE OF COORDINATED AND INDEPENDENT SPENDING', to (1) permit gubernatorial candidates participating in the Citizens' Election Program to raise additional funds and qualify for supplemental grants, (2) eliminate grants from the Citizens' Election Fund for candidates without an opponent, (3) modify the amounts of organization expenditures that state central, legislative caucus and legislative leadership committees may make to participating candidates, (4) permit members of the State Elections Enforcement Commission to serve more than two consecutive terms, (5) revise the manner in which the commission processes complaints, (6) create bright lines between coordinated and independent spending, and (7) implement federal court rulings regarding the creation of independent expenditure political committees.

REF. GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS

H.B. No. 5523 (RAISED) GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS. 'AN ACT CONCERNING DEPOSITS OF CONTRIBUTIONS IN CANDIDATE COMMITTEES' DEPOSITORY ACCOUNTS', to permit a candidate, in addition to the treasurer of such candidate's candidate committee, to be able to deposit contributions in such committee's depository account.

H.B. No. 5524 (RAISED) GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS. 'AN ACT CONCERNING CAMPAIGN FINANCE DISCLOSURES', to make a technical revision to a campaign finance statute.

REF. GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS

H.B. No. 5525 (RAISED) GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS. 'AN ACT CONCERNING CAMPAIGN FINANCE UNDER THE CITIZENS' ELECTION PROGRAM', to (1) limit to two hundred fifty dollars any contributions to party committees by candidates participating in the Citizens' Election Program, and (2) eliminate grants from the Citizens' Election Fund to candidates without an opponent.

REF. GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS

H.B. No. 5526 (RAISED) GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS. 'AN ACT CONCERNING DARK MONEY AND DISCLOSURE', to (1) implement federal court rulings regarding independent expenditure political committees, (2) increase disclosure of independent expenditures and prohibit such expenditures by foreign-influenced entities, (3) reveal persons behind political committees and contributors to such committees, (4) require online platforms to disclose purchasers of political ads, and (5) increase transparency with respect to moneys paid to consultants.

H.B. No. 5527 (RAISED) GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS. 'AN ACT CONCERNING MINOR REVISIONS TO THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT', to make minor revisions to the Freedom of Information Act.

REF. GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS

H.B. No. 5528 (RAISED) GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE ADMINISTRATION OF GOVERNMENT', to make technical changes to statutes concerning the administration of government, including reporting provisions.

REF. GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS

H.B. No. 5529 (RAISED) GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS. 'AN ACT ADOPTING ATLANTIC STANDARD TIME FOR THIS STATE', to require the state to adopt Atlantic standard time upon the enactment of legislation in Massachusetts and Rhode Island adopting said time and federal approval of such change.

REF. GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION AND ELECTIONS

H.B. No. 5530 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING ILLEGAL PARKING AT A PUBLIC ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATION', to establish that illegal parking at a public electric vehicle charging station is punishable as an infraction.

REF. JUDICIARY

H.B. No. 5531 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING ENHANCED EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES FOR INCARCERATED INDIVIDUALS', to require the Commissioner of Correction to establish a job training program that permits an incarcerated individual to participate in a vocational training program that is designed to qualify the individual for an apprenticeship position upon release from incarceration.

REF. JUDICIARY

H.B. No. 5532 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE GROVE BEACH POINT ASSOCIATION', to amend the charter of the Grove Beach Point Association in Westbrook.

REF. PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

H.B. No. 5533 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATE'S CONSOLIDATED PLAN FOR HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT', to specify certain fair housing goals in the state's consolidated plan for housing and community development and to report progress made towards such goals.

REF. PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

H.B. No. 5534 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE CLASSIFICATION OF FARM LAND', to prohibit a municipal assessor from denying the application of a land owner for classification of such land as farm land if such land meets the criteria for classification as farm land.

H.B. No. 5535 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING A TAX CREDIT FOR CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES', to authorize municipalities to allow a property tax credit for electric vehicles, hybrid electric vehicles and motor vehicles that run on biomass fuel.

REF. PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

H.B. No. 5536 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING CONTRACTORS WITH OBJECTIVE RECORDS OF PRIOR POOR PERFORMANCE', to authorize municipal planning, zoning and planning and zoning commissions to require contractors with objective records of prior poor performance to post bonds in amounts and durations specified by such commissions.

REF. PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

H.B. No. 5537 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING SHARED SOLAR FACILITIES AND MUNICIPAL AIRPORTS', to create a pilot program for shared solar facilities at municipal airports.
