H.B. No. 5538 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING A NONEXPIRING AMMUNITION PERMIT', to allow an option for a life-time ammunition permit.

REF. JUDICIARY

H.B. No. 5539 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING FIREARMS IN STATE PARKS', to permit persons to carry firearms in state parks.

REF. JUDICIARY

H.B. No. 5540 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING GHOST GUNS AND THE PERMIT APPLICATION PROCESS', to ban guns without serial numbers and regulate those which are sold in a form requiring the purchaser to finish assembly or that are homemade and to permit local authorities to interview immediate family members as part of a determination of an applicant's suitability.

H.B. No. 5541 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE LIABILITY OF LAND SURVEYORS', to require an owner of land who has requested a survey of his or her land to provide not less than seven days' advance written notice to certain other landowners prior to performing the land survey.

H.B. No. 5542 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING BUMP STOCKS AND OTHER MEANS OF ENHANCING THE RATE OF FIRE OF A FIREARM', to ban the sale or transfer, possession, manufacturing or use of bump stocks or other accessories to increase the rate of fire of a firearm.

H.B. No. 5543 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE TRUST ACT', to foster trust between residents and city and state officials, ensure public safety and promote a welcoming community for all.

H.B. No. 5544 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE CONNECTICUT SENTENCING COMMISSION WITH RESPECT TO MISDEMEANOR SENTENCES', to enact the Connecticut Sentencing Commission's recommendations with respect to misdemeanor sentences.

H.B. No. 5545 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING LOCAL AND STATE COOPERATION IN THE ENFORCEMENT OF FEDERAL IMMIGRATION LAW', to ensure that local and state officials are fully cooperating with law enforcement personnel in the enforcement of federal immigration law.

H.B. No. 5546 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING LARCENY AGAINST AN INTELLECTUALLY DISABLED PERSON', to enhance the penalty in the case of larceny committed against an intellectually disabled person.

H.B. No. 5547 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING ACCOUNTABILITY FOR THE EARNED RISK REDUCTION CREDIT PROGRAM', to require that inmates adhere to their offender accountability plans and actively participate and complete eligible programming in order to earn risk reduction credits.

H.B. No. 5548 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING INMATE FURLOUGHS', to limit the circumstances under which a serious felony offender may be granted an inmate furlough.

H.B. No. 5549 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING CRIMINAL DEFAMATION', to make certain acts involving workplace defamation a class A misdemeanor.

H.B. No. 5550 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE CRIME OF FALSELY REPORTING AN INCIDENT IN AN EMPLOYMENT CONTEXT', to hold a person criminally liable when such person knowingly reports a false occurrence or incident about an employee to the employee's employer.

H.B. No. 5551 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT INCREASING PENALTIES FOR DEALING SYNTHETIC DRUGS', to amend the definition of "narcotic substance" to add fentanyl and fentanyl derivatives in order to increase penalties for dealing such substances.

H.B. No. 5552 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING COURT REVIEW OF AN AGENCY DECISION UNDER THE UNIFORM ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT', to revise the Uniform Administrative Procedures Act with respect to a court's review of an agency decision.

H.B. No. 5553 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING CRIMINAL LIABILITY IN THE CASE OF DRUG OVERDOSE DEATHS, INCREASING THE PENALTY FOR THE POSSESSION OF A NARCOTIC AND CRIMINALIZING THE MISBRANDING OF SYNTHETIC DRUGS', to establish the crime of manslaughter by causing a death of another person by drug overdose, make possession of a narcotic a class D felony, to criminalize the false labeling of synthetic drugs to include as illegally supplying a drug, a prescribed narcotic to a person for whom it is not prescribed and to require opiates be labeled to better warn of addictive qualities.

H.B. No. 5554 (RAISED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING REGIONAL FINANCING OPTIONS', to expand municipal regional financing options.
