**H.B. No. 5555 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE YOUTH VIOLENCE INITIATIVE'**, to include in the list of towns that may receive a Youth Violence Initiative grant the town of Waterbury.

**REF. JUDICIARY**

**H.B. No. 5556 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE EVALUATION AND TRACKING OF PROSECUTIONS OF CRIMES COMMITTED WITH THE USE OF A FIREARM'**, to require the Connecticut Sentencing Commission to evaluate and track outcomes resulting from the prosecution of persons charged with committing a crime with a firearm.

**H.B. No. 5557 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE COMPETENCY OF A DEFENDANT TO STAND TRIAL'**, to provide a judge with greater discretion in determining how frequently a defendant should be examined to determine his or her competency to stand trial.

**H.B. No. 5558 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING JUVENILE MATTERS'**, to provide for the transfer of serious juvenile criminal matters to the adult docket of the Superior Court where appropriate and to repeal an obsolete provision of the general statutes.

**H.B. No. 5559 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE TRANSFER OF CASES OF REPEAT JUVENILE FELONY OFFENDERS TO THE REGULAR CRIMINAL DOCKET'**, to require the transfer to the regular criminal docket of cases of juvenile offenders who are charged with having committed a third or subsequent felony after having been previously adjudicated delinquent for two or more offenses designated as felonies or who have injured an innocent person during the commission of a felony.

**H.B. No. 5560 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE AUTHORITY OF THE COURT TO ENFORCE ZONING REGULATIONS'**, to allow the Superior Court to impose a minimum fine in the amount of five hundred dollars payable by a person who has violated a zoning regulation.

**H.B. No. 5561 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT IMPROVING CODE ENFORCEMENT PROCESSES'**, to permit a municipality to issue on-site citations in order to improve the municipality's code enforcement process and reduce the rate of repeat offenders.

**H.B. No. 5562 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE JUVENILE JUSTICE POLICY AND OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE'**, to implement the recommendations of the Juvenile Justice Policy and Oversight Committee concerning reforms to the juvenile justice system and to transfer juvenile justice functions from the Department of Children and Families to the Judicial Branch.
