H.B. No. 5583 (RAISED) FINANCE, REVENUE AND BONDING. 'AN ACT CONCERNING A TAX CREDIT FOR EMPLOYERS THAT EMPLOY INDIVIDUALS CONVICTED OF A FELONY AND ALLOWING ACCESS TO THE NEIGHBORHOOD ASSISTANCE ACT TAX CREDIT BY CERTAIN BUSINESS FIRMS', to establish a tax credit for employers that employ individuals convicted of a felony and to allow access to the tax credits under the Neighborhood Assistance Act by business firms that invest funds in nonprofit organizations that hire individuals released from the custody of the Department of Correction.

H.B. No. 5584 (RAISED) FINANCE, REVENUE AND BONDING. 'AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TAX CREDIT FOR EMPLOYERS THAT PROVIDE PAID FAMILY AND MEDICAL LEAVE BENEFITS AND CONCERNING FAMILY AND MEDICAL LEAVE ACCOUNTS', to establish a tax credit for employers that provide paid family and medical leave benefits and to authorize the Treasurer to establish a family and medical leave benefits account program.

H.B. No. 5585 (RAISED) FINANCE, REVENUE AND BONDING. 'AN ACT CONCERNING ENTERPRISE ZONES', to (1) require the Commissioner of Economic and Community Development to develop specific benchmarks to assess enterprise zone benefits recipients, and (2) allow said commissioner to negotiate certain property tax exemptions with a business seeking enterprise zone benefits and the chief elected official of the municipality in which such enterprise zone is located.

H.B. No. 5586 (RAISED) FINANCE, REVENUE AND BONDING. 'AN ACT WAVING CERTAIN INITIAL OCCUPATIONAL LICENSING FEES FOR CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS', to waive certain initial occupational licensing fees for certain individuals.

H.B. No. 5587 (RAISED) FINANCE, REVENUE AND BONDING. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE COMMISSION ON FISCAL STABILITY AND ECONOMIC GROWTH', to require the Commission on Fiscal Stability and Economic Growth to refine the recommendations made in its final report issued March 1, 2018.

H.B. No. 5588 (RAISED) FINANCE, REVENUE AND BONDING. 'AN ACT CONCERNING AN ANALYSIS OF THE REVENUE STREAMS OF THE STATE', to require the Commissioner of Revenue Services to analyze the revenue streams of the state.

H.B. No. 5589 (RAISED) FINANCE, REVENUE AND BONDING. 'AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF FINANCE POLICIES TO IMPROVE THE ECONOMIC COMPETITIVENESS OF THE STATE', to require the Commissioners of Economic and Community Development and Revenue Services to study the finance policies of surrounding states.

H.B. No. 5590 (RAISED) FINANCE, REVENUE AND BONDING. 'AN ACT CONCERNING BOND COVENANTS AND THE BOND ISSUANCE CAP', to delay the inclusion of certain bond covenants for bonds issued during certain time periods and exclude refunding bonds and temporary borrowings from the calculation of the bond issuance cap.

H.B. No. 5591 (RAISED) FINANCE, REVENUE AND BONDING. 'AN ACT CONCERNING MUNICIPAL REVENUE', to diversify municipal revenue options and phase out the motor vehicle property tax.
