(The House of Representatives was called to order at 11:34 o'clock a.m., Representative Hampton of the 16th District in the Chair.)

SPEAKER HAMPTON (16TH):

(Gavel) Good Morning. The House of Representatives is now in session. Will all members and guests please rise and direct your attention to our guest Chaplain, Alicia Vitagliano of East Haven. Alicia will lead us in prayer.

GUEST CHAPLAIN ALICIA VITAGLIANO:

SPEAKER HAMPTON (16TH):

Is there any business on the Clerk's desk?

CLERK:

Yes, Mr. Speaker. The Clerk has a communication from his Excellency the Governor dated March 27, 2018. This communication withdraws the nomination of Elissa Wright from Noank to be a Human Rights Referee.

SPEAKER HAMPTON (16TH):

Thank you, Mr. Speaker. The Clerk should also note that the Governor has signaled that he will resubmit Ms. Wright's nomination during the Legislative session. The next item of business,

The Committee has met and feels that the Bill should pass, but recommends that it first be referred to the Committee on Finance, Revenue and Bonding.

Finally, Mr. Speaker, the Clerk has a list of Bills, number 29, dated March 27, 2018.

SPEAKER HAMPTON (16TH):

The Chair recognizes Representative Currey.

REP. CURREY (11TH):

Thank you, Mr. Speaker, I move that we waive the reading of the list of Bills and the Bills be referred to the Committees indicated.

SPEAKER HAMPTON (16TH):
