HB 5152

AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY OF MARIJUANA-IMPAIRED DRIVING AND METHODS TO DETECT MARIJUANA-IMPAIRED DRIVING.

SUMMARY:

The bill requires the Department of Transportation (DOT) in consultation with UConn and other state agencies, to study marijuana impaired driving.

The bill requires the commissioner of DOT to submit a report to the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to public safety and security and transportation no later than February 1, 2021.
