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### ***OFA Fiscal Note***

***State Impact:*** None

***Municipal Impact:*** None

### ***Explanation***

This bill: (1) allows prophylaxis<sup>1</sup> by physicians and advanced practice registered nurses, and (2) requires practitioners that provide prophylaxis to minors 12 years of age or younger to report certain information to the Department of Children and Families (DCF) for the purposes of a report. It is anticipated that the number of such prophylaxis cases will be limited and that DCF will produce the required report within its existing resources. Therefore, the bill is not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact to the State or municipalities

House "A" struck everything after the enacting clause of the underlying bill and replaced it with language that is not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact to the State or municipalities, as discussed above.
