## **OFA Fiscal Note**

**State Impact:** None

**Municipal Impact:** None

The bill is not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact to the State or municipalities. It changes the definition of sex discrimination, and allows, by 7/1/20, for the sex of children to be designated as non-binary on their birth certificates, or intersex adults to amend their birth certificates to reflect that status on or after 7/1/21. Birth certificates offering a non-binary designation option have been available since January 2019. As such, no cost to the Department of Public Health or municipal offices of vital records is anticipated.

Senate "A" struck the language of the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact, replacing it with the language discussed above.
