OFA Fiscal Note

State Impact: Potential Cost

Municipal Impact: None

The bill allows parent and family participants of the Two Generational Initiative to be compensated for certain related activities resulting in a potential cost, the extent to which is dependent on the number of applicable participants and the amount paid. It is unclear which agency would be responsible for providing such compensation.

The bill makes other changes that are not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact as the agencies involved have the expertise necessary to carry out the provisions of the bill.

Senate "B" strikes the language and associated fiscal impact in the underlying bill and results in the impact described above.

The Out Years

The annualized ongoing fiscal impact identified above will continue into the future subject to participant compensation levels.
