Explanation

The bill requires the Department of Correction (DOC) to provide injured inmates or their legal representatives with certain documentation if requested and results in a potential revenue gain if the Commissioner adopts fees for the requests.

The bill also requires the DOC to post certain information on its website and results in no fiscal impact.

Senate "A" strikes the underlying bill and results in the fiscal impact described above.

The Out Years

The annualized ongoing fiscal impact identified above would continue into the future subject to the potential fees.
